Matthew 25:35-40

'For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.' Then the righteous will answer him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? And when did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? And when did we see you sick or in prison and visit you?' And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.'

Title: Anywhere, for Anyone

You ever asked someone for directions?

- Who here is like I will figure it out on my own? Some people are like I need help.
- Im that way.
- Leah is not. She gets embarrassed of me. Ever asked someone for help and they didn't work there.
- Help me with where I am supposed to go.

As we end tonight sermon series on serving, I wanted to help you with your direction on where you can serve.

I want to give you some specific direction so you can start right away.

Main Point: Where Can I Serve?

Story I read, there were 6 statements that actually help us focus on where we can serve.

'For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink,

Intimate setting. Close quarters. With those who you are close with.

1. Serve at Home (Image)

Our home is a great place to learn and be a servant. We can serve our parents and our Siblings

Let's start something as teenagers.

Instead of our parents asking us to do something for them or telling us to do something, how about we serve them and do something for them, before they even ask.

How about we do the dishes before they ask us.

How about we clean our room before they ask us to.

Or take out the trash.

Some of us we have a hard time even doing what our parents ask, so maybe its time to change the script and be a servant at our homes.

I be some of our parents would pass out if we did something before they asked.

Deuteronomy 5:16 New International Version

Let's get in a habit of doing things for our parents before they ask us to.
