Point 1: It Humbles Us

Some of us, truthfully, need to work on our humility a little more. We could all us a little more humility. You never hear someone say, I am so humble. If you do, they probably are prideful. We might think a little to highly of ourselves. It's ok to do that, but if you do it to the point where you cannot serve, then there is an issue.

Proverbs 11:2 NIV When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom.

Prideful people are a disgrace. Humble people are wise.

- It is powerful when you can go from acing a class paper to picking up trash around your classroom.
- Or being the leading scorer on your team to picking up chairs after the game.
- Or being viewed as the popular kid, but you are still willing to help clean up the lunch room after.
- Or working on how you look and the clothes you where to helping at a soup kitchen where people do not have money to buy clothes or products for their beauty.

Serving keeps us humble.

It works on who we are. And helps us stay grounded. Some of us are living in the clouds to much.

Point 2: It Grows our faith

Some of us are halted in our faith because we have not stepped out and served people yet.

John 13:17 17 Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them.

Our faith is blessed by serving.

Key areas you can serve - Serve in Church or Serve in your school Kids ministry Youth Ministry Sunday Morning greeting team. Serving will grow you.

15 I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.

Point 3: It makes us more like Christ

Our goal and desire should be to be like Christ. Well we cannot be like Christ if we do not serve. Do not have a heart to serve.

1 Corinithians 11:1 Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.
