SERIES INTRO //

We know that God is perfect, which means not only is what he does perfect, but who he is in character is also perfect!

Tonight we are going to look at how God is not just perfect in what he does, but who he is!

SCRIPTURE // PSALMS 102:26-17 NLT

"They will perish, but you remain forever; they will wear out like old clothing. You will change them like a garment and discard them. But you are always the same; you will live forever."

HEBREWS 13:8

"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever."

MAIN POINT // God's Character is Constant.

- God's character, will, and promises are unchanging.
- God's character does not change with the seasons nor is it based off of conditions / circumstances
- Because God is infinitely, divinely, and eternally perfect he is unable to change! He is the I am that I am!

ILLUSTRATION // Recall a time or ask the students about a time they were friends with someone who they thought was a consistent, reliant friend and they switched up on them! Whether that was due to a new friend or possibly a romantic situationship....

- Most of the time this leaves you frustrated, angry, lonely, and confused because you thought they were your friend.
- In this moment, they did not just switch up on you, their character completely changed.
- This shows how imperfect humanity is in our character, and how divine God is due to simply his strength in character. His character stays the same!!

Numbers 23:19

"God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so he does not change his mind. Has he ever spoken and failed to act? Has he ever promised and not carried it through?"

- God is not a liar, and He will always keep his word meaning who he says he is....he is!
- He will always carry out his character on your behalf.
- Because of God's strength in His consistent character, we can fully rely on him always without fear of denial (God switching up on us).

CHALLENGE / RESPONSE:

- How does your character reflect the consistency of God's character? Have you been 'switching up'?

- Ask God to strengthen your character to look more like Him no matter the circumstance.
- Trust in God's consistent character! He will never change!
