This approach requires more time investment but can be more effective for long-term growth.

Consult: Personalized Guidance

The third approach, 'Consult,' is the most time-consuming but potentially most effective. It involves providing personalized guidance and advice based on the leader's specific context and situation. This approach combines elements of conveying new ideas, coaching, and consulting to tailor support to each leader's unique needs and challenges.
