TENSION //

<u>MAIN POINT//</u> DANGEROUS PRAYER: BREAK ME

SCRIPTURE 1 // MARK 14:3

While [Jesus] was in Bethany, reclining at the table in the home of Simon the Leper, a woman came with an alabaster jar of very expensive perfume, made of pure nard. She broke the jar and poured the perfume on his head.

<u>APPLICATION //</u>You can have all of my life! Everything I have. Everything I am!

- Her gift represented her <u>past</u>. (Leaving my sinful life.)
- Her gift represented her <u>future</u>. (Savings and my provision)

ILLUSTRATION // Cortez told the sailors to burn the ships...

• Refused to go backwards. Made retreat impossible.

SCRIPTURE 2 // MARK 14:22-24

²² As they were eating, Jesus took some bread and blessed it. Then he <u>broke it</u> in pieces and gave it to the disciples, saying, "Take it, for this is my body." ²³ And he took a cup of wine and gave thanks to God for it. He gave it to them, and they all drank from it. ²⁴ And he said to them, "This is my blood, which confirms the covenant between God and his people. It is <u>poured out</u> as a sacrifice for many.

Broken and poured out!

Luke 22:19 - And [Jesus] took bread, gave thanks and <u>broke it</u>, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; <u>do this</u> in remembrance of me."

APPLICATION //

Do **this**. Live a life of brokenness to God's purpose. **Do this**. Not just the ritual, the act itself. Be broken and fully dependent on God!

Break me of pride. Break me of love this world. Break me of self!

ALTARS & SALVATION RESPONSE //

When the sinful woman broke the jar—Didn't hold back a single drop. When Jesus' body was broken—Gave his whole life.
