- 1. <u>Ask someone to briefly summarize/Any questions about anything you heard tonight?</u> (Encourage your group by leading with any of your own questions and how they might be answered)
- 2. <u>Would you ever join to be a contestant on the bachelor or bachelorette? Why or why</u> <u>not?</u> (Allow the students to drive the stories. If needed, tell your own to get it started)

3. <u>What are your feelings about Esther throughout her journey of being taken and put in</u> <u>this beauty competition?</u> (Again, let the students drive this. If conversation is slow to start, begin with your own response.)

4. <u>How can we discover the gifts and talents God has blessed us with?</u> (What are you passionate about? What have others complimented you on? Run it by your mentors who will speak to you truthfully about gifts and talents he or she has noticed in you.)

5. <u>How are we able to use our gifts and talents to point others towards a loving God?</u> (Talk in generalities and move towards specifics. Picking up on gifts that you can personally see in your students.)
